

FLEA TREATMENT PREP SHEET

Preparations Prior To Treatment:

Clearing Spaces:

- Remove all objects from under beds and small items from floors to allow access for thorough treatment.
- Clear all carpeted floors, including closets, of boxes, clothing, and any items that may obstruct treatment.

Pet Bedding:

• Wash pet bedding in hot water or dispose of it if washing is not possible. Seal it in a plastic bag and discard it in an exterior trash bag.

Vacuuming:

- Vacuum all carpeting and rugs meticulously, paying attention to corners, edges, and areas where pets spend time.
- Carefully vacuum pet sleeping and resting areas, including under furniture, cracks in floors, and draperies.
- Vacuum furniture thoroughly, especially between and under cushions.
- Vacuum wood, tile, and vinyl floors. Vacuuming is preferred over mopping as it effectively removes fleas.

Disposal:

• Empty the contents of the vacuum cleaner into a plastic bag and dispose of it immediately in an outside container.

Pet and Food Preparation:

• Remove pets from the home before treatment. Store or cover all food, including pet food, and remove the litter box.

Aquariums:

 Cover aquariums and turn off pumps. If you have saltwater fish, inquire about specific instructions for their care during treatment.

Pet Treatment:

• Arrange for flea-infested pets to be treated simultaneously with the home.

<u>At Time of Treatment:</u>

HVAC Units:

Turn off HVAC units to prevent the dispersal of treatment materials.

Vacation of Premises:

Vacate the house for at least 4 hours to allow treated floors to dry thoroughly.

After Our Treatment:

Ventilation:

 Air out the house by opening doors and running the HVAC system for 5 minutes.

Resumption of Normal Activities:

Resume normal use of the house and floors.

Carpet Shampooing:

 Avoid shampooing carpets for at least two weeks to ensure the treatment remains effective.

Continued Vacuuming:

 Continue daily vacuuming for a week. Dispose of vacuum bags in sealable plastic bags after each use.

Garment Laundering:

 Launder and dry garments on a hot cycle to eliminate any fleas or eggs that may be present.

Follow-Up Visit Preparation:

• Repeat all preparations on the day before the follow-up visit scheduled 14-21 days after the initial application.

<u>Note:</u> Your cooperation in completing these preparations is crucial for the effectiveness of the treatment. Following these steps diligently will maximize the success of flea eradication in your home.
