

Rodent Cleanup and Prevention Sheet,

Preparation:

Gather necessary supplies:

- Latex or rubber gloves
- Disinfectant spray
- Paper towels
- Plastic garbage bags
- Soap and/or rubbing alcohol

Ensure proper ventilation in the cleaning area.

Cleaning Up After Mice:

- **Protection:** Wear latex or rubber gloves to protect your hands.
- **Disinfect:** Spray the area with disinfectant and allow it to saturate for at least five minutes.
- **Removal**: Use paper towels to remove rodent droppings, disposing of them in plastic garbage bags.
- **Reapplication:** Reapply disinfectant over the cleaned area and neighbouring spots.

- **Garbage**: Avoid storing garbage in the garage or inside the house.
- Bait Stations: Do not move bait stations from their designated locations.
- **Regular Maintenance**: Vacuum and maintain sanitation regularly to prevent rodent infestations.
