CRAWLING INSECTS TREATMENT PREP SHEET

Dear Customer / Tenant,

We have been tasked by the Management of the building to conduct a routine pest control service in your premises to prevent a **CRAWLING INSECTS** infestation using residual sprays and dusts. The service will be performed on _____.

To ensure the success and effectiveness of the treatment, we kindly request your cooperation in following the instructions below:

Preparation Prior to Treatment:

1. Remove all items from the following areas:
 - Kitchen cupboards, drawers, refrigerator tops, stovetops, and countertops. Place them on the kitchen table and cover them with plastic sheeting or blankets to prevent contamination.
 - Shelves and floor perimeters in all closets and linen cupboards. Items from these areas can be placed on beds without requiring covering.
 - **Note:** Hanging clothes can remain in closets and will not be affected by the treatment.
2. Remove birds and pets from the premises. Cover fish tanks and pumps to prevent poisoning. Plants on windowsills should be removed or covered.
3. Move furniture in all rooms as close to the center as possible, allowing access to the baseboards for treatment.
4. Everyone must vacate the premises for at least 4 to 6 hours. Individuals with allergies, asthma, pregnancy, children under 4, or respiratory problems should leave for 12 to 24 hours.

Treatment:

- Treat all cracks and crevices, including areas such as under table tops, behind sinks, in cabinets, and in refrigerator motor compartments. Spray all baseboards in the house.
- Inspect for points of entry and potential food sources for crawling insects.

After Treatment:

- Wash kitchen countertops, breadboard, refrigerator, and stovetops with soap and water. Do not wash cupboard shelves and drawers.

- Place paper on shelves and in drawers before returning any items. Do not remove paper for at least three (3) weeks from the treatment date.

Additional Instructions:

Do:

- Wipe down and vacuum infested areas, disposing of vacuumed contents immediately in outdoor garbage.
- Remove items from infested areas and place them on a raised hard surface, covering them with a sheet or plastic.
- Remove pets from the house and cover fish bowls during treatment.

Don't:

- Leave any food exposed during treatment.
- Inhale the insecticide spray.
